

Launch:

Launch took place on Saturday 2nd May 2015, and went well. All boats were in the water by 12:30 pm, significantly earlier than in previous years. As the crane is paid for by the hour, this should save the club some money.

Thanks to all of those who came out and helped with launch, particularly Wayne Hind who drove the forklift , Andy Hellenbart for directing the crane, and the ladies in the galley.

The Channel:


The channel has been dredged. Initial soundings revealed that it was not in bad shape, however there were some issues between the creek and the first set of marks. It has also been widened out to allow easy passing of boats. There is still a bend in the channel as you leave the creek, but its almost a straight shot thereon.

The Harbour:

All boats that needed to be accommodated, have been, and there are a couple of empty wells within the harbour.

F Dock:

There are 3 boats including Moe Regnier's (power boat) on F dock. Although the water depth in the creek is good, a ridge of leaves has been deposited over winter behind the docks along F dock running parallel to the shore. This effectively means that only boats with relatively low draft can get into F dock.


