

2019 AGM Summary and New Executive Committee

37 members were present to hear the committee chair's reports of the past season.

The Treasurer's final financial report will not be available until the next membership meeting, but John Shaw gave a summary indicating that the club finances are in good shape. 12 notes were drawn from the Harbour Reconfiguration fund, leaving a balance owing of \$68,000.

A motion was passed approving a new Social Membership class.

A committee will be formed, and meet over the next few months to review our by-law. The by-law is affected by upcoming provincial legislation, ONCA. These meetings will be open to all members, more info to come.

Commodore Tim Aseltine awarded the Jaques Marian award to Fred Eagan in recognition of all of the work he has put in as harbour master. The high water levels presented some challenges, but with Fred's efforts, we got through the season and have a plan in place for next year.

The nominating committee's report for the 2020 executive was accepted and flags were passed.
