September Calendar of Events

Harbourmaster Andy Hellenbart

I hate to be a bearer of bad news but the end of sailing season is coming. The haulout for this season is scheduled for October 30th and cradle moving for October 23rd. Attached you will find the **2021 WINTER STORAGE RELEASE FORM AND THE FEE SCHEDULE**. Please fill them out and return them by **October 1st** so that the winter storage can be organized. For the haulout, we will follow the same procedure as we did for the launch. (Pg 7-8)

In the mean time let us be courteous to our neighbours and tie back your halyards to keep them from slapping at the mast.

With the COVID restrictions and the weather conditions, there has not been much sailing activity at the dub. I would like to recommend you to check on your boat to make sure it is safe. With the water level fluctuations and the wind conditions, some of the boats had to be retied because they were banging into the docks. Also some of the anchors hanging from the bow pulpits were overhanging the dock and making it difficult to walk on the dock.

We are not in a position to set out garbage or recycle bins at this time. Please continue to drop garbage in the driveway bin and use the recycle tubs south of the back deck. No garbage in the dock carts or rolling blue recycle bin please ! Your cooperation is appreciated.

With the rise in Covid cases in our area, we will be locking the outside washrooms again. Inside facilities are available. Continue to follow the WECHU directives, masks, & sign in to the clubhouse and follow cleaning directions in washrooms after use for everyone's safety.

As an update the following items were taken care of last month. The hall freezer was replaced, the screens were replaced on the sun porch, 5 new wooden picnic tables were delivered and assembled, the broken light fixture at the back door was replaced and the honey bucket pump was rebuilt. The shed was partially power washed and the concrete blocks organized and set on new pallets. Thank you to the volunteers who carried out these tasks, and those who regularly clean the sidewalks and docks of goose droppings.

At some point the end of this month or first part of October (date to be determined when the heat lets up) I would like to get a group together to paint the sun porch. An email will be sent out asking for volunteers. If you work during the day and need work hours, we will accommodate a late day/evening painting party.
