AGM Tuesday November 24th

This years AGM was a bit different, as were most events throughout 2020. 16 members attended the club and 19 via the web. Committee reports were emailed to the members prior to the 24th for review.

A moment of silence was held to remember 5 long time senior members who passed during 2020.

The club welcomed 11 new members this year in all categories bringing the membership to 112.

Commodore Ramey thanked the members and each executive chair for a job well done during Covid 19 in dealing with all the Government restrictions and Health guidelines throughout the year, and acknowledged the new incoming Board members.

The highlight of the meeting was presented by the Harbour Reconfiguration committee chair, Brenda Petro. In 2013 the club realized they were going to have to take great measures to find a way to reconfigure the harbour, but the question was how. With an 85% membership vote in favour, a committee was formed consisting of 9 members. On October 29, 2013 a letter went out to the membership proposing the members finance the project by way of Promissory Notes. An overwhelming response brought the necessary \$240,000 to carry it out. Each year 5% was required to be paid, which would have taken 20 years. Keeping the club budget in check the past 7 years, allowed us to pay off all of the remaining 68 notes this year !

Thank you to the members who stepped up in 2013, the original committee, Brenda Petro-Chairperson, John Shaw-Treasurer and our Club solicitor Dave Connor for keeping the financial records. With the high water levels the past few years, work has continued on the docks and we have a beautiful, functional harbour.
